## KUWALA 2ND DORM



**Project:** Build a second dorm on the Kuwala campus (1hr West of Lilongwe, Malawi)

**Completion:** 2021

**Concept:** Design + Build + Commission.

**Business Requirements:** The 2nd dorm will follow the engineering blueprints and lessons learned from the first dorm we built on the Kuwala campus. This will house 60 students in 15 rooms. A typical dorm is 4 students per room in two bunk beds.

Our plan's key component is to complete a 120 all-girl school with four grades of 30 students each. We are creating a quality, safe environment for learning. We believe educating girls is the strategy to break the cycle of poverty in Malawi. A donation goes a long way and will provide positive changes for decades.



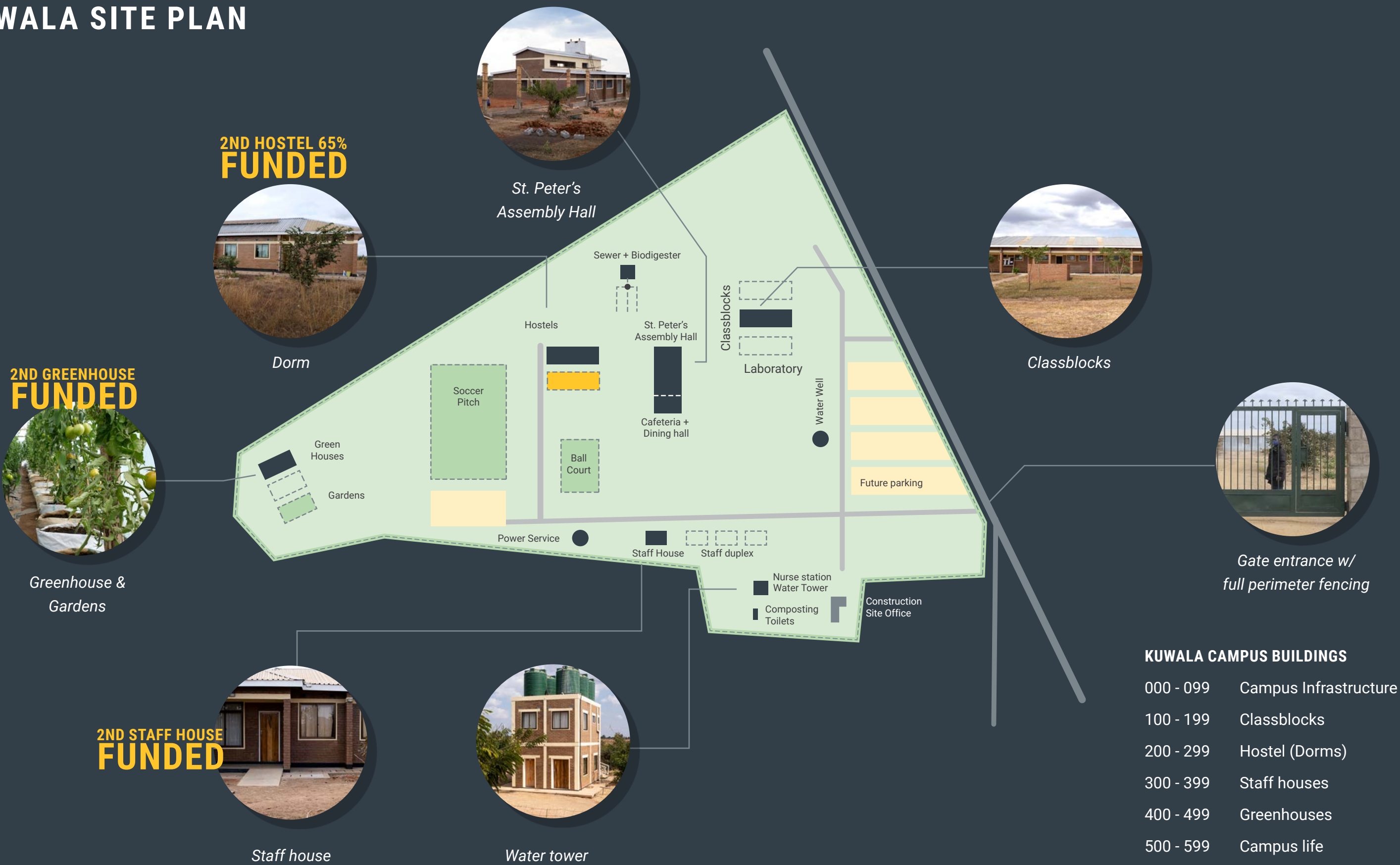
### **The opportunity:**

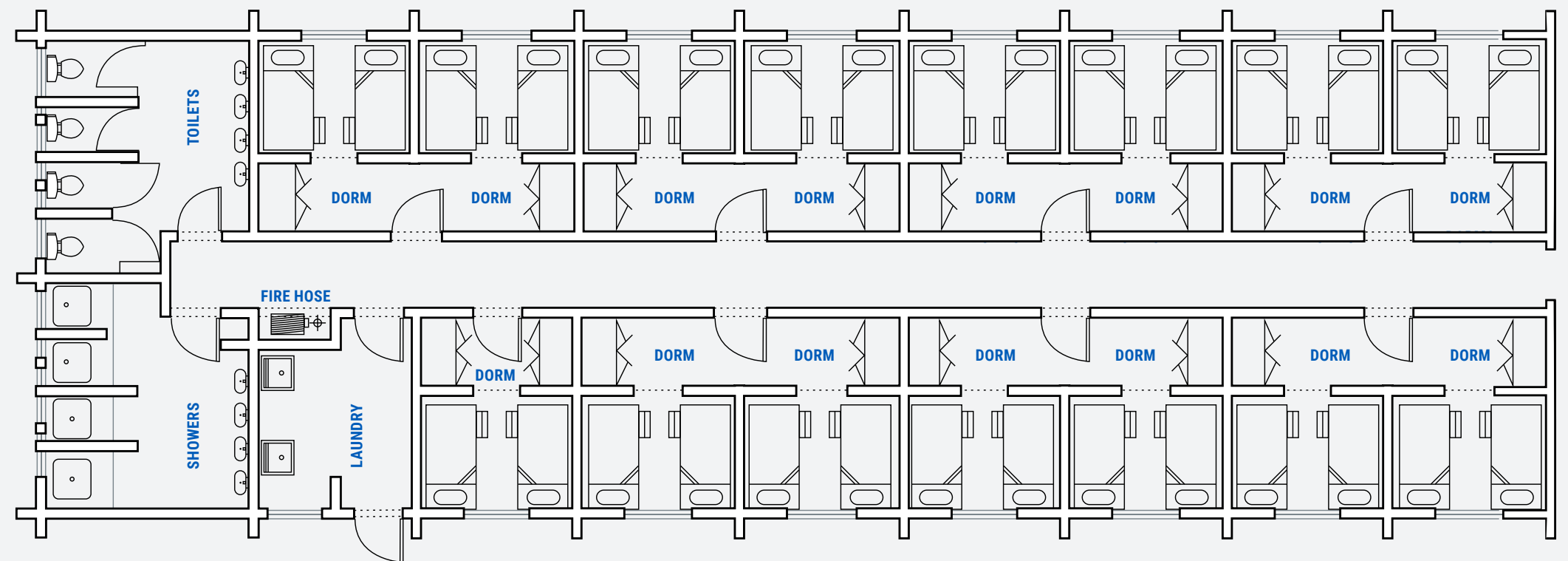
