Our initial group of 60 students, together with our next group of students, starting in January, will bring us to our goal of 120 students. This comprises students in all of Forms 1-4, of the secondary school model. We look forward to annually graduating 30 students as we register 30 new students. These girls will graduate with confidence, enthusiasm and be ready to change their world for the better!

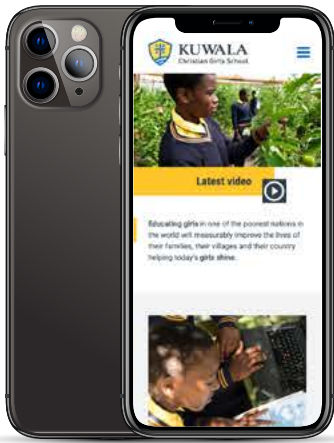
With the impact of the COVID pandemic, next year in Malawi will see a short, compacted academic year, as the nation strives to realign back to a normal school year beginning in September of 2022. To do that we will see three terms – January to March / March to June / and June to the beginning of September (**2 week breaks between terms**), when we will have our first graduates. Our staff is ready for the challenge and our students enthusiastic to learn.

As a new school, we had a dual focus of building the needed infrastructure, while at the same time, making sure we have sponsors to support the costs to deliver quality classroom education with excellent teachers, in a safe, secure and nurturing environment.

Thank you for being one of those sponsors! We can't begin to appropriately express what your support has meant and how you are changing lives.

As we grow to our targeted capacity of 120 students, we need more people like you! Please consider sharing what you are doing with friends and family, forwarding our newsletter and letting them know we need their support.

Our campus continues to develop, and the landscape is growing green. This past year, we have added to our facilities the St. Peter's Assembly Hall, our second staff house, our second student dormitory and our second greenhouse, all while continuing to plant 100's of trees, our school orchard and outdoor gardens. All of these projects will be complete by year-end.
